**Proficiency Level:** Intermediate

Lesson Length: 90 minutes

Vocabulary and Expressions: Parts of the body, commands for moving the body

Lesson Topic: Asking for clarification

**Language/Culture Point:** Review of content from Lesson 3 ("Injuries") and Lesson 5 ("Making a Doctor's Appointment")

**Objective:** Students will be prepared for simple conversations with volunteers and business staff.
