It focuses on teaching communicative language in the classroom with the goal of having students learn language skills that can be immediately applied to negotiate daily life in an English-speaking environment.

English Forward Instructor Guide

At the heart of the Guide is the ESL by Design Lesson Flow, which is covered extensively during the Instructor Training. The Guide also includes communicative teaching strategies and teaching tips for instructors, and it dives deeper into the research and theory introduced during the training.

English Forward Curriculum

Designed for beginning-level adult ESL classrooms. The Curriculum covers the first 60-100 hours of instruction, and its 40+ lessons focus on life skills that students will be able to immediately apply outside the classroom. Included in the Curriculum are tips for teaching multi-level classrooms, teacher lesson reflections, Can Do Lists, and lessons adapted for literacy-level classes.



The training is rooted in research on second language acquisition, adult learning theory, studies in cognitive science, and research on adult ESL literacy. Participants learn practical, effective strategies and activities for teaching beginning-level ESL and ways to adapt activities for more advanced learners.

The training is led by Literacy Forward Master Trainers who were themselves trained by renowned experts in the field. The training focuses on teaching communicative language in the classroom, with the goal of having students learn language skills that can be immediately applied to negotiate daily life in an English-speaking environment.

Each participant receives the English Forward Instructor Guide. At the heart of the Guide is Dr. Heide Spruck Wrigley's research including her ESL by Design lesson planning framework, which is covered extensively during the Instructor Training. The Guide also includes communicative teaching strategies and teaching tips for instructors. Many of the Guide's teaching strategies and activities are covered during the English Forward Instructor Training, and instructors then have the Guide to use as a resource once they enter the classroom.

Heide Spruck Wrigley, PhD is Senior Researcher and President of Literacywork International, a small independent social science research firm focused on education and training for vulnerable youth and adults. She has been key in a number of large scale national studies involving limited English proficient adults, including the What Works for Adult ESL study and the National Adult ESL Literacy Demonstration Project.

Currently, she is advising and providing technical assistance to projects across the United States and internationally. These include the Gates Foundation-funded English Innovations project in Seattle, Washington, the BTOP Learner Web project in Portland, Oregon, the Carlos Rosario International Adult ESL Public Charter School in Washington, DC, the Washington State Board of Community and Technical Colleges (I-BEST), and the Illinois Coalition on Immigrant and Refugee Rights. She is a consultant with Jobs for the Future focusing on Career Pathways and Contextualized Learning and a non-resident fellow with the Migration Policy Institute. Her current international work is centered around professional development for teachers of English for Special Purposes for vulnerable youth in Rwanda.
