

Lesson Length: 1.25 hours + Extension Activities

Vocabulary & Expressions: Vocabulary related to filing taxes

Language/Culture Point: Phrasal verbs with "do"

**Objective:** Students will be able to discuss doing their taxes.

Materials: Sample paystub, sample W-2s, signal cards, computer, projector, 1040EZ,

Internet connection, index cards, internet connection







## STEP 1: ACTIVATE BACKGROUND KNOWLEDGE

Time Frame	Materials	Teaching Strategies
10 minutes	- Sample paystub - Sample W-2	- Authentic Materials

#### TEACHING ACTIVITY

- 1. Start by asking your students if they have jobs, or if they have had a job in the US. Ask them if they receive all of the money their company pays them, i.e. if they work for 10 hours at \$10/hour, do they get \$100?
- 2. Bring in a sample paystub and share it with your students. If your state has income tax, be sure that it is represented on the paystub. If you don't have a readily accessible example, you can find an example using Google or create your own using a website like:



www.pay-stubs.com

- 3 After the students have taken a quick look at the paystub, ask questions like: "Whose paystub is this?"; "Where do they work?"; "How much money have they made this week/ year?"; "How much federal income tax was taken out? Social Security? Medicare?"
- 4. Tell students that in the beginning of each year you have to do your taxes to make sure that you paid the right amount in the previous year.
- 5. Pass out a sample W-2 that shows all of the federal, state, and local taxes taken out, as applicable in your community.

# STEP 2: MINI-PRESENTATION WITH PROMPT

## **TEACHING ACTIVITY**

1. Do a Chalk Talk in which you tell the story of how you file your taxes. Points to include are: when you received your W-2 and when employers have to mail them out, going to the library or going online to get a 1040EZ, filling out the form and doing your taxes, getting a refund/making a payment, and sending it in before April 15.

## STEP 3: DISCUSSION AND COMPREHENSION CHECK

#### **TEACHING ACTIVITY**

1. Make true and false statements about the process of filing taxes and the materials needed. Have students use Signal Cards to indicate True/False/I don't know.

#### STEP 4: HIGHLIGHT LESSON FOCUS AND MODEL TASK

10 minutes	- Computer and projector - 1040EZ	- Authentic Materials - Think Aloud

#### **TEACHING ACTIVITY**

- 1. Tell the class that today you are going to talk about filing your taxes and that you will practice filling out tax forms.
- 2. Project a copy of the 1040EZ tax form onto the board. Conduct a Think Aloud as you model how to fill out the form and where to find the information on the W-2. Have the class follow along with their copy of the W-2 as you search for the information and then include it on the 1040EZ.

3. Fill out the rest of the form.

#### **STEP 5: GUIDED PRACTICE**

#### **TEACHING ACTIVITY**

1. Project a new blank copy of the 1040EZ form on the board. Provide the class with another W-2 sample. Ask for a student to help you fill out the form this time using the new W-2. Take turns asking each other for the targeted information.

#### STEP 6: PAIR OR SMALL GROUP WORK

# **TEACHING ACTIVITY**

- 1. Ask students to get into pairs. Provide each pair with a blank copy of the 1040EZ tax form and another W-2 sample. You can provide each pair with the same sample.
- 2. Have the students in their pairs take turns filling out the different parts of the tax form.
- 3. Once they have completed the tax form, ask each group to share a piece of the information they recorded on their form. For example, they could share the first/last name on the W-2, or the information that goes in lines 1-14 of the 1040EZ.

## STEP 7: HIGHLIGHT HOW ENGLISH WORKS

#### **TEACHING ACTIVITY**

- 1. Write the phrase "do taxes" on the board. Tell your students that "do" is used to describe performing some activities.
- 2. Create a chart with one column on the board. Over the column write "do"...
- 3. Write the word "taxes" under the "do" column.
- 4. Ask your students if they know of any other activities that are described using "do". Common examples include do the dishes, do laundry, do exercise, do homework.

# STEP 8: QUICK CHECK AND REVIEW

5 minutes	- Index Cards	- Exit Check

#### **TEACHING ACTIVITY**

- 1. Create a set of questions about doing taxes using index cards, being sure that there are enough to ask each student one question. The questions should refer to the information found on a W-2, the information required on a 1040EZ, or information about when a W-2 should be received, the deadline for doing your taxes, and so on.
- 2. Pass the cards out to your students. Tell them to look at card and be prepared to give you the answer to the question.
- 3. As students leave have them return the index card to you. Ask the question and have the student provide the answer.





# **EXTENSION ACTIVITY: GUEST SPEAKER/USING THE TAX TABLE**

### **TEACHING ACTIVITY #1**

1. Ask your students if they are interested in having a tax professional visit the class to talk about taxes.

Hosting a tax professional as a guest speaker is a good opportunity for your students to learn about the taxes they or their friends/family members pay. Your students can learn more about the taxes that are taken out of their paycheck and where their money goes. It is also a good opportunity for them to ask any questions they might have.

#### **TEACHING ACTIVITY #2**

- 2. With your students, find the taxes due for each of the W-2s used in this lesson. Have them complete the 1040EZ to determine if the person owes money or receives a refund.
